Times Tables Practice

This does not need to be a long time; just 5 minutes a day can make all the difference. Your child should have a Times Tables Rockstars account where they can access plenty of games and activities to support their learning. If your child can confidently recall all facts, they should challenge themselves to know the corresponding division facts. If you have further questions, please do not hesitate to contact your child's class teacher.
